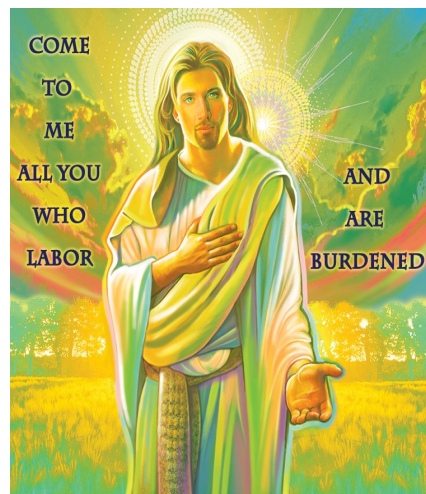

**Stewarding our Gifts** - "Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life". So what does it look like to glorify the Lord by your life? How, exactly, does one do that? **St. Patrick Restoration/Building Project Update:** With Bishop Kemme granting us permission to continue forward with our proposed Master Plan, last week on Wednesday evening, June 28, Father Linnebur, along with Mike Wescott (Director of Development and Planned Giving for the Diocese), and 13 members of our parish leadership interviewed 2 firms for an upcoming feasibility study. The first was Betty Johnson & Associates from Lawrence, KS, and the second was the Steier Group out of Omaha, NE. In the course of the interviews and in the discussion following them, it became apparent to the parish leadership that Betty Johnson & Associates would be a better fit for our parish needs.

As a result, a contract has now been signed, and in the weeks to come, Betty Johnson & Associates will be working directly with our parish to conduct a feasibility study. Again, the feasibility study itself will consist of interviewing a variety of parishioners for their input and thoughts regarding the Master Plan, as well as what they think they will be able to offer in financial support. Betty Johnson & Associates will conduct these interviews, and the responses will be totally confidential. The firm will then summarize their findings from the interviews and present them to our parish. In the end, this feasibility study will give us valuable insights as to what financial support we as a parish can expect to raise for this restoration/building campaign. The feasibility study will also help us to determine if we need to make any adjustments to the current Master Plan. As I'm sure you would agree, this planning time is crucial to the long term development of our parish. Let us continue to pray for one another. May we be open to the Lord's will as we join together at this very important time for our St. Patrick Church family.
