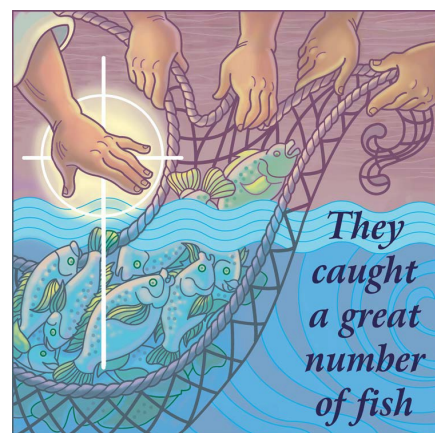

**"Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples"** It would seem that the word of the day is CONVERSION. In the first reading, the prophet Isaiah acknowledges his "unclean lips" (unworthiness) in the presence of the LORD of hosts, but with the aid of the seraphim his wickedness is removed and his sin is purged. He has been changed -- prepared, even -- to go and do the work of the LORD. In the gospel, we see Simon Peter go through a similar change, from a fisher of fish to a fisher of men. In both cases we see God taking an ordinary human and preparing him for an extraordinary mission. To be fully alive it requires conversion of heart and mind. When you look in the mirror, you may see an ordinary man or woman, but remember that you have been baptized into an extraordinary mission. Pray that God will reveal that mission to you and that you will be of heart and mind to accept that mission with enthusiastic gratitude!
