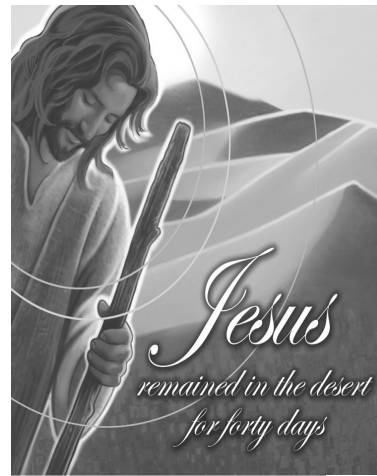

Lenten Fast & Abstinence Regulations - *Ash Wednesday, Feb. 18th & Good Friday are days of fasting.* Catholics who are ages 18 to 59 are obliged to fast, that is, take only one full meal and two lesser meals, with nothing to eat in between meals. Drinking fluids would not be contrary to the practice of fasting. *Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday are days of abstaining from meat.* All Catholics who are 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from eating meat.

Holy Hours A/B/C - March 1st at 5:00pm and March 8th at 4:00pm-First Confessions will follow at 5:00pm.

Wednesdays of Lent the school children will have Stations of the Cross at 2:30pm, everyone welcome!
